

Princess Wand

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Time to Complete: Approximately 45 minutes Level: Medium



GETTING STARTED

What you'll need to complete the Princess Wand:

- Scissors or X-ACTO knife
- Metal-edged ruler (optional)
- Butter knife
- Cutting mat (optional)
- Multipurpose glue

- 1 Score: Using a metal ruler as a guide, run the backside of a butter knife along all of the dashed lines.

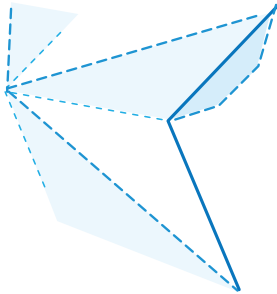


- 2 Using scissors or an X-ACTO knife and cutting mat, cut out wand pieces on solid lines.

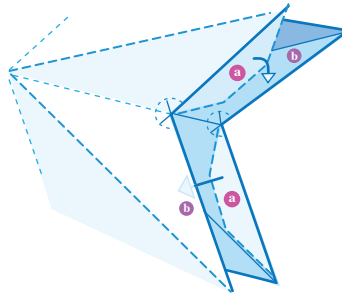


ASSEMBLE YOUR PRINCESS WAND

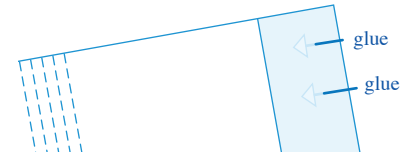
- 3 Fold the star together to give it shape. The dark blue-dashed interior lines indicate mountain folds, the light blue interior lines indicate valley folds.



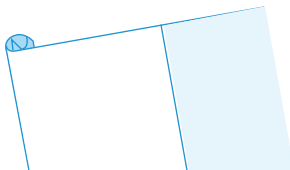
- 4 Apply glue to the glue tabs. Align the two sides of the star, leaving the hole (for the wand handle). Affix the glue tabs **a** to the interior edge of the opposite side **b**.



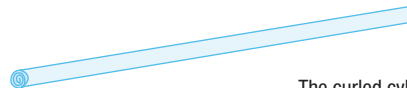
- 5 Apply glue along the long edge of the unprinted (or back) side of the right edge of the paper (opposite the pattern, not the edge with the fold lines).



- 6 Fold and roll together 3-4 times along the fold lines at the left side. This folded section will give you something to tightly wrap the rest of the handle around.

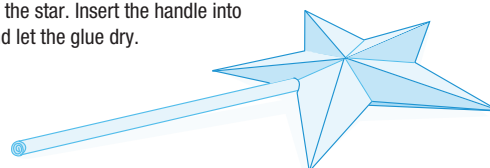


- 7 Tightly curl the rest of the paper around the folded section and adhere glued section when you come to the end.



The curled cylinder should be no wider than 1/4 inch.

- 8 Apply glue to the small sections at the opening of the star. Insert the handle into the star and let the glue dry.
